## **KENT REGION PUBLIC WORKSHOP SUMMARY**

March 1, 2006

Troy Mix opened the public workshop by addressing the public and committee members present. He gave a brief overview of the CEDS process for the members of the public not familiar with the process. With the assistance of the committee members, Troy then summarized the vision statement, goals, objectives, recommendations, and project proposals that had evolved from the Kent County Committee meetings. The public and the committee exchanged dialogue regarding these topics. Bernard Dworsky continued the workshop by discussing the remaining steps in the process of completing the CEDS.
